The North Fork Community Development Council is moving forward with the planning for constructing a 1MW bioenergy generation facility at the town's former Mill Site. The project is a strategic step to producing green energy and finding economic uses for biomass material generated by forest management and hazardous field treatment activities in the area. It is also an important step towards redeveloping the mill site and restoring the town's economy.
